OUR CITY LIMITS AND CITY OWNED LAND

Many "Lakesidians" don't know just where our city limits are and what land our city actually owns.

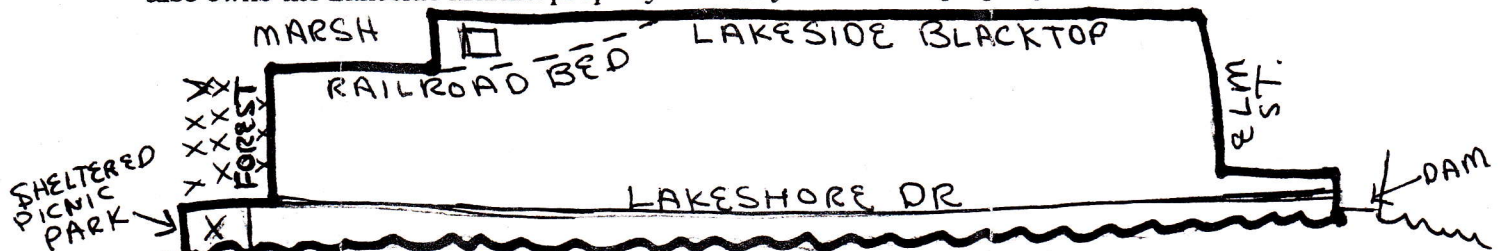
EAST LIMITS- the lakeside blacktop. All houses on the east side of the highway are in the county.

WEST LIMITS- of course, runs along the lake from the dam north to the Lakeside picnic shelter's parking lot. The lake property is owned by the adjoining lots down to the "high water mark" of the lake.

SOUTH LIMITS- behind the houses on the south side of Elm St. --to Lakeshore Dr--. then south along Lakeshore Dr. to the dam.

NORTH LIMITS- a little complicated- runs from the blacktop north of *empty lot which used to be Louie Henderson's*-- to the old railroad bed--then north along the railroad bed to the forest (north of Mandeville park) --west along the forest to Lakeshore Dr--then over to the north side of the Lakeside picnic shelter parking lot.

In addition to Mandeville, Edson, and Fredrickson parks and the 7 lake access lots, Lakeside also owns the Lakeside Marina property. ~~Twenty houses that property was once owned by~~
